On average, state employee donors to the Colorado Combined Campaign give about a dollar a day. As you can see from these examples, the impact of a relatively small amount of money is huge!

\$1 a day supports one elder's monthly trips to the grocery store.

\$1 a day provides four children each with a backpack filled with school supplies.

\$1 a day enables one training for youth and adults experiencing homelessness about their rights when dealing with police.

\$1 a day provides training to five childcare providers about the importance of not smoking around kids.

\$1 a day provides training for up to 50 people about issues affecting the autism community.

\$1 a day supports well-visits for 100 children.

\$1 a day provides seven participants with a bus pass and a hot, healthy breakfast for one month.

Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver

\$1 a day provides one yard for a child to play in.

Inside the Orchestra

\$1 a day enables one classroom of high-need students to sit in the center of the orchestra during a performance.

Kids in Need of Dentistry

\$1 a day provides an exam, cleaning, fluoride treatment and x-rays for 13 children.

March of Dimes Foundation

\$1 a day provides parent-care kits to 20 families with babies in intensive care.

Mercy Housing

\$1 a day provides after-school programs for 12 kids.

Rocky Mountain MS Center

\$1 a day buys the supplies for a 16-week painting class for a disabled adult.

Special Olympics Colorado

\$1 a day purchases ski equipment for one athlete.

TRU Community Care

\$1 a day trains two volunteers in relaxation and pain relief therapy for hospice patients.

Volunteers for Outdoor Colorado

\$1 a day engages 30 young people in an outdoor stewardship learning opportunity.

Wapiyapi

\$1 a day provides supplies for volunteers for three camping sessions.

W.O.L.F.

\$1 a day provides an annual exam and blood tests for one wolf dog.
