We're shifting into post-pandemic life, but many of the needs brought to the fore remain. That's why we ask for your support of the 2021 CCC.

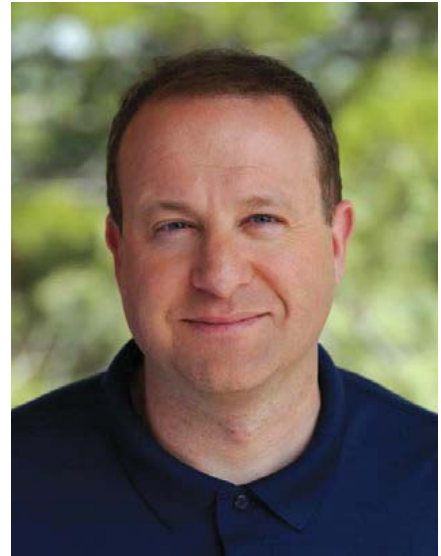
